



¶¶ Accordingly, the parties stipulate that “petitioners are entitled to compensation under the terms of the Vaccine Program.” Stipulation at ¶ .

On , the parties filed the attached joint stipulation, stating that a decision should be entered awarding compensation. The undersigned finds the stipulation reasonable and adopts it as the decision of the Court in awarding damages, on the terms set forth therein.

Pursuant to the terms stated in the attached Stipulation, **the undersigned awards** the following compensation:

- **A lump sum of \$93,109.00 in the form of a check payable to petitioners as guardians/conservators of the estate of**
- **A lump sum of \$1,891.00, which amount represents reimbursement for out-of-pocket expenses, in the form of a check payable to petitioners in their individual capacity.**

These amounts represents compensation for all items of damages that would be available under 42 U.S.C. § 300aa-15(a). *Id.* Stipulation at ¶

The undersigned approves the requested amount for petitioner’s compensation. In the absence of a motion for review filed pursuant to RCFC Appendix B, the clerk of the court is directed to enter judgment in accordance with this decision.<sup>3</sup>
